Rule #1: HTML works with <TAGs>. Most tags have an opening <TAG> and a closing </TAG> Rule #2: Some tags only need one tag (no opening and closing tags) such as
 (Notice the position of the / character) Rule #3: You can embed tags but make sure you respect the order for opening/closing the tags. Rule #4: Each tag can be customised using attributes: <BODY bgcolor="#FF0000"> (BGColor is an attribute of the BODY tag)
